The standard format for the State of Ohio birth certification is a summary of facts as recorded from the original birth record. The birth abstract does not include protected medical information or original signatures; the summary format increases legibility of certificates.

The certified record does include the required standard birth information. It is accepted by all local, state and federal government agencies, including Passport, Social Security, school systems, etc.
